BEFORE YOU GET STARTED:

Ensure a safe and well-spaced environment for your installation. Remove all included parts included in the accessory kit.

This kit contains very strong magnets, proceed with caution!

For your safety and convenience, DO NOT REMOVE THE PROTECTIVE SPACERS between the magnets until absolutely necessary. If the magnets fuse together it will be very difficult to separate them again.









THIS IS A STRONG MAGNE


- It can be harmful to pacemaker wearers and others with medical implants.

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Using the plier end on the Busch Systems Multi Tool, remove plugs on desired connection sites. (FIG 1)



- Carefully install the bolts onto the striker plate and magnets as shown (Extremely important to do so on the magnet). (FIG 2)
- Using the Allen key end on the Busch Systems Multi Tool, install the striker plates and bolts as shown, then repeat with magnet and bolt. Be careful not to overtighten the bolts. (FIG 3)
- Install all four (4) magents in to the opposite end of the connection point; ensure a magnet is opposite a striker at each connection point. (FIG 4)
- To connect, slowly pull the bins close together to join the magnetic plates use caution and keep all other objects away from magnets, especially being careful not to pinch fingers, etc. (FIG 5)



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
