



We only recommend and use quality first grade materials on our containers, and source these from OEM's at highly-competitive prices. The design process, materials used, finishes and manufacturing standards all affect the final product. Every decision is vital to getting the most value for your investment. You deserve recycling, waste and PPE containers that meet your demands for quality and durability and will enhance your working environment for years to come.

Busch Systems[®] Recycled Plastic Lumber products are made from 97% maximum-strength, post consumer HDPE (most often recycled milk jugs!). The Paladin Series stations do not absorb moisture, are resistant to rotting, heat & mold and are developed using the highestquality, rust-resistant hinges, fasteners & screws. Commercial-grade resins and UV resistors are added to the recycled lumber during the manufacturing process to prevent fading due to sun and harsh weather exposure.

The LEED® green building certification program is the nationally accepted benchmark for the design, construction and operation of green buildings. Busch Systems® recycled plastic lumber receptacles are made of 97% pure post-consumer HDPE and may contribute to your LEED® goals under MR 4.1 and MR 4.2.

INSTALLATION

Busch Systems[®] Paladin[™] Series containers are hassle-free when it comes to installation. Each container comes fully-assembled and individually boxed using high-density cardboard with high-recycled content to ensure safe and environmentally friendly transport.

To install your Paladin Series containers:

- 1. Remove unit from pallet and place in desired location
- 2. Apply your Chosen labels
- 3. (Optional) Install your hand sanitizer dispenser (Please Note: Hand Sanitizer are not included in the purchase of Paladin units
- 4. Insert the recycling/waste bag into each liner and wrap the top edge of the bag around the liner.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Advantages of Busch Systems® Recycled Plastic Lumber receptacles include:

- Made from 97% maximum-strength, post consumer HDPE (most often recycled milk jugs!)
- Highly-durable material and is able to withstand physical stress to a greater degree than wood.
- Minor dings and scratches are much less likely to bend your containers out of shape or leave the finished scratched.
- Do not absorb moisture, are resistant to rotting, heat & mold and are developed using the highest-quality, rust-resistant hinges, fasteners & screws.
- Commercial-grade resins and UV resistors are added to the recycled lumber during the manufacturing process to prevent fading due to sun and harsh weather exposure.

Their appearance and lifespan will be greatly affected by their care. The frequency of cleaning required depends on the environment in which the containers are used. Outdoor containers will be subject to different environmental conditions than indoor units, i.e. sun, rain, wind, pollution, winter temperatures, and salt/sea air.

To avoid the accumulation of dirt and grime on your Busch Systems[®] products, and help prevent corrosion, we recommend that a mild detergent be used (not an abrasive), such as a pH-neutral liquid (hand dishwashing or hand car washing soaps, for example) diluted in warm water. Rinse well with clean water. Any dirt adhering to the powder coating should be removed. In order to remove deposits such as salt or dust, use a soft brush (non-abrasive). If this is not sufficient to remove stubborn soiling, the following products have been tested for use:

Note: Always test soaps/cleaners on a hidden and/or small area beforehand

- Ajax Cream
 Flash (in water)
- Liquid Gumption
 - Cutting compound ('T. Cut')

If solvents are absolutely needed to remove marks, a soft cloth dampened with white spirit may be used.

• Ajax Liquid (in water)

GENERAL CARE

•

- Clean with a mild detergent and damp sponge or cloth
- For tougher cleaning purposes, Lysol, TSP or Spray Nine may be used
- To remove permanent marker on melamine, use a small amount of Lacquer Thinner or Acetone on a cotton rag

THINGS TO AVOID

- Cleaners with chloride or bleach
 Strong Solvents
- Abrasive detergents
 Steel wool or Scouring pads
- Trapped moisture between product and equipment such as rubber mats
