COVID-19 Safety Plan

Busch Systems developed and delivered a robust & immediate action plan to protect our employees in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. This included mandatory health and safety measures, along with furtherincreased cleaning & sanitizing procedures. Busch Systems continues to support a remote workforce and provides financial compensation for vaccination and/or testing, as well as full payment of wages if an employee needs to selfisolate. Due to this dedication and standard of care, to date we have had zero cases of COVID-19 in our facility!

When an aquifer that fed three boreholes ran dry and expected rains were delayed by months, communities in Dekpor were left without safe drinking water. Busch was able to finance the solution, and a large, new aquifer was found and connected to the underground system. We are honoured to enable people and organizations that are doing good around the world, as well as in our local communities.

New RISE Series

When our customers talk, we listen - and we never stop innovating to meet their changing needs!

This year, Busch Systems launched our first-ever wall-mounted containers. Through research, design, and fantastic customer feedback, we have created a system that rises above the rest and allows our customers to conserve space & keep floors clean without having to move their containers. The RISE Series incorporates a multi-stream solution with a low profile that minimizes disruptions in narrow spaces.



New Virtual Tradeshow Space

To ensure our customers – both current and potential – receive the best customer service available, this year we converted a large office space into an entirely virtual Trade Show Room. This area is complete with a wide range of products on display, two webcams set up to showcase the products from multiple angles, and a full web-conference tech set-up with HD video & sound.





STAR (State of Texas Alliance for Recycling) Bin Grant

In 2020, we partnered with STAR (State of Texas Alliance for Recycling) to award seven 'Bin Grants' to deserving applicants seeking to improve their recycling programs. The grants were awarded by an impartial panel on a competitive basis to municipalities, a high school, and community NGOs. We donated the 29 Waste Watchers and 225 combo Deskside Recycling containers, along with consultations to help the winners launch or overhaul their office waste programs based on proven best practices that ensure engaging, efficient, and effective recycling participation. 2021 was our second year supporting the program, and we will be repeating it and matching our donations again for 2022.



Support for National Recycling Coalition (NRC)

Busch Systems is a dedicated supporter of the National Recycling Coalition (NRC), a member-based NGO whose mission is to bring together different recycling industry stakeholders including businesses, NGO's, trade associations, government agencies and advocates to collaboratively develop solutions to advance recycling systems and conserve natural resources. Our Senior Advisor, Alec Cooley, is an elected board member, Chair of the Fund Development Committee, and Co-chair of the Conference Commitee. In 2019, Busch partnered with several colleges and universities to pilot numerous recycling & waste collection arrangements and document improvements to recycling rates and waste diversion programs.

Some informative highlights include:

- Our study with the University of Georgia showed that sign frames added above waste bins improved the amount of recyclables collected by 18% and reduced contamination by 14%.
- Our Case Study at Indiana University Purdue University Indianapolis (IUPUI) showed that converting personal deskside bin configuration to the combination of a regular recycling bin with a smaller hanging trash basket improved recycling by as much as 100%, and saves the school up to \$30,000 annually (with reduced bag liner purchases).

Our programming is designed for sustainability and waste management professionals, combining best practice case study presentations with extended, interactive Q&A panel discussions from experts in varying fields across Canada and the United States. Our 2021 webinars attracted over 1,000 attendees, and we look forward to continuing our free 'GreenThinking' programming into 2022.

2020 Campus COVID Survey

In Fall 2020, Busch and our Senior Advisor Alec Cooley spearheaded a collaboration with the College & University Recycling Coalition (**CURC**), the US Composting Council (**USCC**), and other organizations to survey over 150 colleges & universities across Canada and the US to understand how COVID-19 was impacting recycling and waste recovery programs nations-wide. The results revealed a trend showing an increasing number of schools have re-organized their office & classroom waste infrastructure around centralized collection. This model involves consolidating the network of smaller bins typically disbursed throughout a building down to a smaller number of larger, centrally-located waste and recycling stations. Case studies have shown this arrangement, combined with related changes to custodial duties, can significantly improve recycling participation and reduce contamination. These stats and conclusions were published in an article, co-written by Alec Cooley, in the respected industry trade journal Resource Recycling.

B-Corp Recertification

One of our most important goals for the next year will be to complete our tri-annual B-Corporation recertification in December 2022. In 2021 we got to work, already laying the groundwork to surpass our original certification score (82.1) achieved in 2019.

Our B-Corp certification status is extremely important to all of us at Busch Systems – it shows our employees, customers, and the world that we hold ourselves to the highest level of social and environmental standards. We decided to pursue B-Corp certification in 2018 to publicly demonstrate our active commitment to building our community, reducing waste, and doing what we can to leave the world a little better than we found it.

To be certified as a B-Corporation, any company must commit to a legally-binding responsibility to protect the interests of its workers, the community, and the environment, in addition to its shareholders. Once initially certified, corporations must complete a public B Impact Report Assessment every 3 years and meet B-Lab's comprehensive social and environmental performance standards in order to maintain their certified with B-Corp status.
